Understanding Apple Books Family Sharing

This means that a single purchase can be enjoyed by multiple people, fostering a shared appreciation for literature and preventing duplicate purchases. It's an excellent way to introduce family members to new authors or genres they might not have discovered otherwise, all within the convenient Apple Books platform.

It's important to note that not all content is eligible for sharing. Generally, books purchased from the Apple Books store that are not associated with specific educational or subscription-based services are shareable. Content from certain third-party apps or subscriptions that integrate with Apple Books might have different sharing policies. Always check the purchase details or the publisher's guidelines if you are unsure about the shareability of a particular book.

Setting Up Family Sharing for Apple Books

There isn't a separate setting specifically for Apple Books; it's managed under the general "Share Purchases" setting for the entire Apple ID.

Once Family Sharing is set up and purchase sharing is enabled, managing your shared Apple Books library becomes an intuitive process. Family members can access shared books through their own Books app, and the organizer has oversight and control over the shared content.

Accessing Shared Books

Purchasing New Books for the Family

When a family member wants to purchase a new book, they can do so from the Apple Books store as they normally would. If purchase sharing is enabled, this newly purchased book will automatically become available to other family members after a short period. The organizer can also choose to enable "Ask to Buy" for younger family members, which requires the organizer's approval for any purchase, including books. This is a great way to manage spending and ensure that the books being purchased are appropriate and desired by the family.

Removing Content from Shared Library

If a book needs to be removed from the shared library, the family member who originally purchased it can do so. They would navigate to their own purchase history within Apple Books or the App Store, locate the specific book, and then opt to stop sharing it. Alternatively, if the organizer wishes to stop sharing all purchases, they can disable the "Share Purchases" option within the Family Sharing settings. It's worth noting that when a book is removed from sharing, any family member who had previously downloaded it may lose access.

Access Denied or Purchase Error

Ensure that the family member is signed into their Apple ID on their device and that they are indeed part of the active Family Sharing group. If they were recently added, it might take some time for their account to fully sync with the family group's shared content. Checking for software updates on all devices involved can also resolve compatibility issues.

Ineligible Content for Sharing

As mentioned earlier, not all content is shareable. Books that are part of a subscription service (e.g., Apple Books Plus if it were to exist in a shared format), or those with specific publisher-imposed restrictions, will not appear in the family library. If you purchased a book and believe it should be shareable but it isn't appearing, confirm its eligibility by checking the purchase details or contacting Apple Support. For subscription content, each family member may need their own subscription unless the service explicitly supports Family Sharing.
